☐ Bath towel and washcloth / hand towel - 2 sets	☐ Shoes for end of the day and travel: sneakers / moccasins - extra pair - Note: Tennis shoes must be cleaned and washed. Please, no smelly shoes!
☐ BSA Handbook for Boys	☐ Sleeping bag / bag liner / or sheet and 2 blankets
☐ Boy Scout Uniform (1 set to be worn)	☐ Sleeping pad. E.g., Therm-a-rest, closed-cell foam, egg crate, etc.
☐ Cup (for drinking bug juice, water, etc.)	☐ Sock liners (nylon, polypropylene or similar) - 4 pr.
☐ Day pack / hip pack	☐ Socks - Extra pairs to keep feet dry and clean. - Several pair
☐ Face masks	☐ Socks, Scout - 3 or more
☐ Gold Bond Powder (Travel size for feet, shoes, irritated skin, etc.)	☐ Sunscreen and lip balm w/ sunscreen
☐ Hand sanitizer - travel size	☐ Toiletries: DEODORANT, soap, toothpaste, toothbrush, comb / brush
☐ Light sweatshirt / jacket / etc.	☐ Troop 48 cap
