SCHEDULE:

- Meet at Faith Presbyterian Church Saturday at 6:00 PM Friday.
- Depart Faith Presbyterian by 6:30 PM. Drive will be approximately 1 hour.
- Pick up at Faith Presbyterian by 2:30 PM on Sunday.

Weather:

- Friday: Rain very likely with the low in the mid-50's.
- Saturday: Clear skies with the high in the mid-60's, the low in the lower 40's.
- Sunday: Clear skies with the high near 70.

Dress Code:

- **Scouts travel in Class 'A' (full) uniform**
- Scouts may change into other weather appropriate attire upon reaching destination.
- **Scouts should be in Class A Uniform to compete in the competition and attend the campfire**
- **Scouts should be in Class B Uniform** outside of campsite during the weekend.

Packing suggestions:

- Scouts will need a daypack to carry to the competitions.
 - Personal first aid kit
 - Class A Uniform w/ Neckerchief
 - Rain gear
 - Lunch (packed in camp Saturday morning)
 - Water Bottle
 - Compass
 - Pencil and several pieces of paper
 - Totin' Chip card

 - BSA Scout Handbook
- Be prepared: Bring rain gear
- Prepare for lots of walking: hiking boots recommended

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Other Important Information:

- Scouts need to eat dinner before Friday departure.
- **Scouts can bring a snack to eat after arrival at the campsite.**
- **Please do not eat in personal vehicles.**
- Use of tents is preferred over hammocks due to the high concentration of poison ivy on the edge of the campsites.
- Weather permitting, we will be stopping at The Velvet Cream in Hernando on the way home. There we will be treated to ice cream by the troop committee.
