Dress Code:

- **Scouts travel in full Field (Class 'A') Uniform.**
- Scouts may change into other weather appropriate attire upon reaching destination.
- **Scouts will wear full Activity (Class 'B') Uniform for Friday and Saturday.**
 - **Don't forget your troop hat.**

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Other Important Information:

- Adults must have a valid Real ID or U.S. Passport for admittance to Camp Shelby and the National Naval Activity Museum (NNAM).
- For NNAM:
 - **NO weapons permitted, which includes knives.**
 - **NO day packs permitted.**
 - Only water in an enclosed container with a secured lid may be brought into the museum.
 - No outside food is allowed in the museum.
- We will be sleeping on bunks with mattresses at Camp Shelby and on the floor at Spanish Trails.

- Sandals or similar to wear on the beach and in the shower.
- Be prepared: Bring rain gear.
